

# School uniform - extracurricular activities

A school's dress requirements play an important role in promoting positive self image of the school and creating a sense of identity among students. An established dress code assists in building school and team spirit, encourages equity between students, and contributes to student safety, comfort and well-being.

## Choir

For all performances, choir students are required to wear a clean navy polo shirt (with school logo), navy skorts/shorts, closed in black shoes with white socks, hair neat and with long hair tied back in a plain band or blue ribbon/scrunchie. Navy winter zip jackets (with school logo) may be worn in cold weather.



## Swim Squad

School swim caps are compulsory for swim squad members at training and interschool carnivals. (Swim caps will be donated by the P&C at the beginning of the swim season.) School racer bathers are optional, but preferred.

For all other students, the bathers and cap are optional.



## Hockey

All hockey participants are required to wear their sports uniform + blue and white striped AFL socks.

(Participants to supply their own hockey stick, mouthguard and shin guards.)
